

Soul and gospel legend and civil rights activist Mavis Staples won a 2011 Grammy Award for her best-selling album *You Are Not Alone*, produced by Wilco's Jeff Tweedy. Starting the show will be singer/songwriter, pianist, arranger and producer Allen Toussaint, a hugely influential figure in New Orleans R&B. 




## Berlin Nights/Paris Days: **The Art of Chanson**




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
