



Inspired at the Chan presents: Youth Talent Show

Rules and Regulations

Inspired at the Chan Presents: Youth Talent Show is open to all children and youth between the ages of 10 and 18 who reside in Vancouver. This event will be held at the Chan Centre for the Performing Arts on Sunday, February 18th, 2024 from 3 to 4pm, as part of the Kids Take Over UBC. All contestants entering the talent show must be willing to perform in the live show if selected.

Please note that the finalists from our 2023 Youth Talent Show are not eligible to compete in the 2024 competition but are welcome to re-enter the contest in 2025.

How to enter:

1. Preliminary Audition:

- Create a video showcasing your talent: playing an instrument, singing, dancing, magic, or any other creative talents. Only submit one entry per contestant/group. The judging panel for preliminary auditions will select up to 12 contestants to perform at the final performance at the Chan Centre for the Performing Arts on Sunday, February 18th, 2024 at 3pm.
- Submit an online registration form along with the audition video by no later than 11:59pm on December 18th, 2023.
- Guidelines for filming:
 - Camera orientation: film using a phone horizontally (landscape mode).
 - Video quality: film on the highest HD setting your phone provides.
 - Contestants are asked to state their name and age before beginning their recording.
 - Video performance – no longer than 2 minutes.

2. Final Live Show at the Chan Centre

- The selected contestants will be notified by January 10, 2024. Those selected will perform live at the Chan Centre for the Performing Arts on Sunday, February 18th, 2024 in front of a panel of judges and live audience. Contestants will be adjudicated on their overall performance, audience response, originality, personality, and stage presence.
- Prizes:
 - Top Award: \$300 Cash Prize and three pairs of tickets to any Inspired at the Chan shows over the next two years.
 - People's Choice Award: \$200 Cash Prize and three pairs of tickets to any of the Inspired at the Chan shows over the next two years.
